Then you vote for your favorite soups, and when all the ballots are tallied, the 2010 SOUPER BOWL Champ is determined. The winner will receive the "People's Choice Award."

There will also be a select Judges' Panel. The judges are: Alex Lee, Iron Chef; Wendy Collett, personal chef; Beverly Halm, NY Assoc. of Cooking Professionals and Coordinator of "Grand Chefs of LI, Port Washington Public Schools Continuing Education;" Anne Arter, gourmet and representative of the Head Coach sponsor Daniel Gale Sothebys International Realty, and Tamillah Alexander, a gourmet and deaf-blind student from the Helen Keller National Center. The winner, as determined by a vote of the panel, is given the prestigious "Judges' Choice Award."
